Dear P7 Parents/Carers,

These are the final details for the P7 Outdoor Learning Residential Trip to Barcaple. School staff going to Barcaple: Miss Maclean, Mr Lynas, Mrs McKenzie, Ms McCann and Mrs McLaney

Your child should come to school for 9am on Monday 5th March as normal.

Please bring your child's luggage and leave it on the stage area in the main building by 9am. P7 leave school for Barcaple at approximately **9.30am**. Parents are welcome to wave the children off outside the school.

P7 return to school at approximately **1pm** on **Friday 9**th **March.** The school will text parents to keep them informed of our progress on the homeward journey and any changes to these timings.

Medicines for Barcaple

If your child needs to take any medicine (including an inhaler) on a regular or non-regular basis (including vitamins, daily supplements, travel sickness pills) please complete the pink form in you Parent Pack to give your permission for staff to administer medicine during this trip (extra forms will be available on Monday morning)

Please sign and date the bottom part of the form if you give permission for your child to have **Calpol Fastmelts** if required.

Completed forms and medicine must be handed to Miss Maclean (who will be on the stage area) between 8.30am and 9am on the morning of departure.

Please remember:

- 1. Children may bring up to a maximum of £5 spending money for occasional tuck/souvenirs in £1 coins, 50ps and 20ps. If you wish your child to have spending money, please bring to school on Monday 5th March in a named, sealed envelope. The children should give their envelope to Miss Maclean.
- 2. Children do not need to wear school uniform on the day of departure.
- 3. Children will need to bring a **packed lunch** on Monday (in a plastic bag)
- 4. If your child is prone to travel sickness, please make sure that they have travel sickness medication for the return journey. A signed medicine consent form (pink) is also required.
- 5. No expensive cameras, jewellery, watches etc are allowed as we are unable to compensate for lost or damaged items.
- 6. Mobile phones are **not** allowed.
- 7. In accordance with Glasgow City Council policy, children are **not** allowed football colours.
- 8. No child will be forced to take part in any activity.
- 9. Your child must carry and repack their own luggage- please refer to Kit List.
- 10. Please remember to include a "change bag" for your child's change of clothes/towel/toiletries for after activities.
- 11. Daily updates on how P7 are getting on in Barcaple will be posted on the school website and Twitter.

We know P7 are looking forward to this Outdoor Learning experience and will gain a lot from this fantastic opportunity.

<u>Please note</u>: Due to recent weather and school closures, we may have to postpone/cancel this trip. We will continue to monitor the situation with Health and Safety as our top priority and will provide you with text updates.
