

We're cracking down on people who start fires. Don't accept it, report it.



What's the problem?

Every day, almost one hundred fires are deliberately started in Scotland. These fires blight our neighbourhoods and can sometimes cause injury or even death.

What we're doing.

All calls will be followed up. There will be on-the-spot fines for over 16s. Under 16s may be made to attend a Children's Hearing and will get special fire awareness education to make them more aware of the dangers of fire-setting. Parents of repeat offenders could face eviction.

How you can help - don't accept it, report it.

All we want you to do, is tell us anything you know about fires that have been started in your area. All calls are completely anonymous and won't appear on your phone bill. You don't have to give us your name or any personal details and you won't be asked to give evidence in court.
