<p>1. Welcome – David welcomed everyone to the meeting.</p> <p>2. Selection of new PTA office holders – David and Lil resigned as Chair/Treasurer and Secretary. David was re-elected as Chair/Treasurer and Sanita was elected to share the role of Secretary. If someone else would be happy to share this role with her, please let David and Sanita know.</p> <p>3. Summary of PTA activities throughout the year In total, the PTA have raised £10,078 and spent £10,720 this year. We held two very successful community events - the Winter Market and the Summer Fair - and raised lots of money at both. We also raised money from the sale of Christmas Cards and auctioning tickets for GlasGLOW. The PTA have funded workshops for all year groups to enhance their education - P1-4 took part in workshops with Wildside Nature and P5 had sessions with Clyde in the Classroom. P6 and P7 were taught Parkour by local organisation Movement Park. We also paid for an extra performance of Aladdin the panto so that the children could be more spaced out in the audience. We have funded the installation of two new noticeboards at the front and back gate to improve communication within the school and the wider community. We have bought Lego and STEM games, gardening supplies, sports equipment and bought every P7 a leavers hoodie. We also bought every new P1 a book and a school tie to welcome them to the school. We have paid for a visit and report from 'Learning through Landscapes' to help the school better use its outdoor spaces for learning and we have also put in a grant application to Dandelion Harvest Grants Programme to help support the recommendations. The PTA have organised gardening days to help improve the school grounds and also helped clear out and paint the tunnel area before the installation of bike storage facilities.</p> <p>4.
